**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A14 Trunk Road (Junction 55 Copdock Mill Interchange,  
Ipswich, Suffolk) Eastbound Entry Slip Road (Temporary  
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - *19th August 2013*

*Coming into force* - - *26th August 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A14 Trunk Road (“the A14”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the County of Suffolk should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A14 Trunk Road (Junction 55 Copdock Mill Interchange, Ipswich, Suffolk) Eastbound Entry Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 26th August 2013.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 9 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Wednesday 28th August 2013, or on any subsequent day until drainage interceptor maintenance works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the entry slip road to the eastbound carriageway of the A14 at Junction 55 Copdock Mill Interchange.

3. The provisions of article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the works or for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes.
