ROAD TRAFFIC

The M11 Motorway (Junctions 11 to 14) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 2nd September 2013
Coming into force - - 9th September 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M11 Motorway (“the M11”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that motorway and on some of those connecting roads, in the County of Cambridgeshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M11 Motorway (Junctions 11 to 14) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 9th September 2013.

2. In this Order:

“tip of the nosing” means, as indicated by the markings on the carriageway, the first point where an entry slip road joins, or the last point where an exit slip road leaves, the carriageway of the motorway;

“the motorway” means the M11 –

- (a) southbound carriageway from the point of the A14 eastbound diverge at Junction 14 to the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road at Junction 11, and
- (b) northbound carriageway from the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road at Junction 12 to the point of the A14 merge at Junction 14;

“a slip road” means the –

- (a) entry slip roads to the southbound carriageway, and the exit slip roads from the northbound carriageway, of the M11 at Junction 14 and Junction 13,
- (b) entry slip roads to the northbound and southbound carriageways, and the exit slip road from the southbound carriageway, of the M11 at Junction 12, and
- (c) exit slip road from the southbound carriageway of the M11 at Junction 11;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 16th September 2013 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

“works” mean carriageway resurfacing, renewal of road markings and road studs and bridge, verge and drainage maintenance;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for, or in connection with, the works or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
