**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A5 Trunk Road and the M6 Toll Motorway (Churchbridge, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - *13th September 2013*  
*Coming into force* - - *20th September 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”), M6 Toll Motorway (“the M6 Toll”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of those roads and three of those connecting roads, at Churchbridge in the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road and the M6 Toll Motorway (Churchbridge, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 20th September 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means –

- (i) the A5 between its junction with Walkmill Lane and the roundabout junction with the A34 Walsall Road and A460; and
- (ii) the A5 between the roundabout junction with the A34 Walsall Road and A460 and the roundabout junction with the A460 and the slip road leading to the M6 Toll at Junction T7, including the circulatory carriageway of that roundabout;

“a slip road” means the slip road leading –

- (i) to the eastbound carriageway of the M6 Toll at Junction T7; and
- (ii) from the westbound carriageway of the M6 Toll at Junction T7;

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“the link road” means the A5 link road leading from the roundabout junction with the A460 and the slip road leading to the M6 Toll at Junction T7 to the roundabout junction with the A34 Walsall Road and the slip road leading from the M6 Toll at Junction T7;

“the works period” means the period starting at 21.30 hours on Wednesday 25th September 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road, a slip road or the link road.

**4.** Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave any side road at its junction with the trunk road.

**5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable in uniform; or
- (c) being used for or in connection with the said works.
