ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1(M) Motorway (Junction 35 to Junction 34) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - *3rd October 2013*

Coming into force - - *17th October 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway and connecting roads, in the Counties of South Yorkshire and Nottinghamshire, is satisfied that traffic on that motorway and some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because carriageway resurfacing, road marking, stud renewal and bridge joint repair works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junction 35 to Junction 34) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 17th October 2013.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 14 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Friday 18th October 2013 or any subsequent Friday thereafter until the said works have been completed, or during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 21st October 2013 or any subsequent Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A1(M) Motorway:

- (i) southbound carriageway from the nose of the exit slip road at Junction 35 to the nose of the entry slip road at Junction 34, a distance of 12,000 metres; or
- (ii) southbound entry slip road at Junction 35 or exit slip road at Junction 34.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission, of a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
