ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A30 Trunk Road (Newtown Roundabout, Longrock,
Cornwall) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic)
Order 2013**

Made - - - - *8th January 2013*

Coming into force - - *12th January 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road (“the A30”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road at Newtown Roundabout, near Longrock, in Cornwall should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Newtown Roundabout, Longrock, Cornwall) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 12th January 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the first length of the A30” means (a) both carriageways of the A30 between the eastern edge of Chy-an-Mor Roundabout and the western edge of Newtown Roundabout; and (b) the A30 from the northern edge of Newtown Roundabout to a point 1000 metres north of that roundabout edge;

“the second length of the A30” means the circulatory carriageway of Newtown Roundabout;

“layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b); and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“the works” mean roundabout improvement and maintenance works;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 14th January 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the first length of the A30 and the second length of the A30.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or remain in the bus laybys adjacent to the A30 eastbound and westbound situated 60 metres north of the northern edge of Newtown Roundabout.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the second length of the A30.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue or ambulance purposes.

7. The provisions of article 4 and 5 shall not apply to a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works or for winter maintenance purposes.

8. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
