**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A20 Trunk Road (Court Wood Interchange, Londonbound Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - - *25th February 2013*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *16th March 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A20 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A20 Trunk Road (Court Wood Interchange, Londonbound Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 16th March 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A20 Trunk Road near Dover in the County of Kent;

“the slip road” means the road leading from the B2011 to the Londonbound carriageway of the trunk road at Court Wood Interchange;

“works” mean essential carriageway resurfacing work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 18th March 2013 or on any subsequent day until 15th September 2014.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
