**The A38 Trunk Road (Barton-under-Needwood, Staffordshire)
(Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

Made - - - -2nd January 2013

Coming into force - -9th January 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on six of those connecting roads, near Barton-under-Needwood in the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Barton-under-Needwood, Staffordshire) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 9th January 2013.

2. In this Order:

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| “a slip road” | means the slip road leading – |
| | i) from the northbound carriageway of the A38 to its roundabout junction with the B5016/Station Road; |
| | ii) from the southbound carriageway of the A38 to its roundabout junction with the B5016/Station Road; |
| | iii) from the northbound carriageway of the A38 to Dogshead Lane (Catholme Interchange); |
| | iv) to the northbound carriageway of the A38 from Dogshead Lane (Catholme Interchange); |
| | v) from the southbound carriageway of the A38 to Dogshead Lane (Catholme Interchange); and |
| | vi) to the southbound carriageway of the A38 from Dogshead Lane (Catholme Interchange); |

“the works period”

means the period starting at 22:00 hours on Monday 14th January 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

(a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;

(b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or

(c) being used in connection with the said works.
