ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1 Trunk Road (Bannister Lane Junction to Hampole Balk Lane Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - *8th May 2014*

Coming into force - - *20th May 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of Doncaster, in the County of South Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road and some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because carriageway resurfacing, road marking, routine maintenance and survey works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Bannister Lane Junction to Hampole Balk Lane Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 20th May 2014.

2. In this Order: -

“the A1” means the A1 Trunk Road;

“bus stop area” means any area of carriageway on a side of the A1 intended for the waiting of buses, which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagrams 1025.1, 1025.3 or 1025.4 in schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

“the works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Tuesday 21st May 2014 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed;
and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to;

- (i) enter or leave the A1 southbound carriageway at its junctions with, Scorchers Hills Lane or Hampole Balk Lane;
- (ii) enter the A1 southbound carriageway at its junction with New Close Lane; or
- (iii) enter or leave the A1 northbound carriageway at its junction with Bannister Lane.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in a bus stop area situated adjacent to the A1 northbound carriageway approximately 45 metres south of Bannister Lane Junction.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission, of a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to any vehicle proceeding in the A1 to or from premises and property which is accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
