

Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(a); and in this definition "carriageway" means a way constituting or comprised in a trunk road (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

"works" mean resurfacing, renewal of road marking and road studs, gully cleaning and landscape maintenance;

"a first works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 22.00 hours on Monday 2nd June 2014 or on any subsequent day until the works to the westbound carriageway and westbound slip road have been completed;

"a second works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 22.00 hours on Monday 21st July 2014 or on any subsequent day until the works to the eastbound carriageway and the eastbound slip road have been completed;

"the first works period" means the period starting at 12.00 hours on Monday 2nd June 2014 and ending when the works to the westbound carriageway and the westbound slip road have been completed;

"the second works period" means the period starting at 12.00 hours on Monday 21st July 2014 and ending when the works to the eastbound carriageway and the eastbound slip road have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or –
 - (a) proceed in the westbound carriageway or the westbound slip road, during a first works period,
 - (b) proceed in the eastbound carriageway or the eastbound slip road, during a second works period,
 - (c) wait in the lay-by adjacent to the westbound carriageway situated just east of Junction 23 Spittals Interchange, during the first works period, or
 - (d) wait in the lay-by adjacent to the eastbound carriageway situated just east of Junction 23 Spittals Interchange, during the second works period.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle –
 - (a) being used in connection with the works,
 - (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes, or
 - (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
