**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A50 Trunk Road (Doveridge, Derbyshire) (Temporary  
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

*Made* - - - - *19th May 2014*

*Coming into force* - - *26th May 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A50 Trunk Road (“the A50”) and connecting roads is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and three of those connecting roads, at Doveridge in the County of Derbyshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) , hereby makes the following Order: -

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A50 Trunk Road (Doveridge, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 26th May 2014.

**2.** In this Order:

“the trunk road” means –  
a) the westbound and eastbound carriageways of the A50 between its roundabout junction with the A515 and its roundabout junction with Derby Road;;

“a slip road” means the slip road leading to –  
a) the westbound carriageway of the A50 from its roundabout junction with the A515, Derby Road and Main Road;  
b) the westbound carriageway of the A50 from its junction with Marston Lane; and  
c) the eastbound carriageway of the A50 from its roundabout junction with the A515;

“the works period”

means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 2nd June 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or a slip road.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
