ROAD TRAFFIC

The A46 Trunk Road (Skellingthorpe, Lincolnshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - *23rd May 2014*

Coming into force - - *30th May 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that trunk road, at Skellingthorpe in the County of Lincolnshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Skellingthorpe, Lincolnshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Friday 30th May 2014.

2. In this Order –

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| “Doddington Roundabout” | means the circulatory carriageway of the A46 at its junction with the B1190 Lincoln Road/Doddington Road; |
| “Carholme Roundabout” | means the circulatory carriageway of the A46 at its junction with the A57 Saxilby Road; |
| “Riseholme Roundabout” | means the circulatory carriageway of the A46 at its junction with the A15 and B1226 Riseholme Road; |
| “Skellingthorpe Roundabout” | means the circulatory carriageway of the A46 at its junction with the B1378 Lincoln Road/Skellingthorpe Road; |
| “the first length of trunk road” | means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A46 from a point 570 metres north of the centreline |

of the Whisby Railway underbridge, to its junction with Doddington Roundabout;

“the second length of trunk road” means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A46 between its junction with Carholme Roundabout and its junction with Doddington Roundabout;

“layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(a) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

"the works period" means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Sunday 1st June 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the second length of trunk road.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby situated adjacent to the –

- (a) southbound carriageway of the A46 1560 metres south of Carholme Roundabout;
- (b) southbound carriageway of the A46 360 metres north of Riseholme Roundabout;
- (c) southbound carriageway of the A46 960 metres south of Skellingthorpe Roundabout; and
- (d) northbound carriageway of the A46 785 metres south of Skellingthorpe Roundabout.

6. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave Skellingthorpe Roundabout at its junction with the access road leading to Decoy Farm.

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

8. The provisions of –

- (a) articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall not apply to any vehicle –
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- (b) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes; and
- (d) articles 4, 5 and 6 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
