ROAD TRAFFIC

The A3 Trunk Road (Hazel Grove Interchange – Thursley Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - *2nd June 2014*

Coming into force - - *21st June 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A3 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A3 Trunk Road (Hazel Grove Interchange – Thursley Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 21st June 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A3 trunk road in the County of Surrey;

“a slip road” means –

- (i) the road leading from the northbound carriageway of the trunk road at Hazel Grove Interchange (A333),
- (ii) the road leading to the northbound carriageway of the trunk road at Hazel Grove Interchange (A333),
- (iii) the road leading from the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at Hazel Grove Interchange (A333),
- (iv) the road leading to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at Hazel Grove Interchange (A333),
- (v) the road leading from the northbound carriageway of the trunk road at Thursley Interchange,
- (vi) the road leading to the northbound carriageway of the trunk road at Thursley Interchange,
- (vii) the road leading from the southbound carriageway of the trunk Road at Thursley Interchange, or
- (viii) the road leading to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at Thursley Interchange;

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

“works” mean inlay, patching, road marking, kerbing, gullies, vegetation clearance, reinstallation of road studs and all associated carriageway works;

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 23rd June 2014 or on any subsequent day until 20th December 2015.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
