**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Auchterarder)
(Amendment) Regulations 2014**

Made - - - - *14th July 2014*

Coming into force - - *24th September 2014*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Auchterarder, Perthshire by reason of the Ryder Cup that is scheduled to take place there during the period from 24th to 29th September 2014.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009^(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Auchterarder) (Amendment) Regulations 2014 and come into force on 24th September 2014.

Amendment

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Auchterarder) Regulations 2014^(b) are amended as follows.

3. In regulation 3 for paragraph (1) substitute—

“(1) Subject to paragraph (3), and during the periods specified in paragraph (2) no aircraft is to fly below 3,000 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 3 nautical miles whose centre is at 561736N 0034459W.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Auchterarder) Regulations 2014 (S.I. 2014/1657) (“the principal Regulations”). The amendment changes the shape and dimensions of the area which is subject to the flying restrictions imposed by the principal Regulations during the period from 24th to 29th September 2014.
