1. This Order may be cited as the Intellectual Property Act 2014 (Commencement No. 2) Order 2014.

**Commencement of section 23 of the Intellectual Property Act 2014**

2. The day appointed for the coming into force of section 23 of the Intellectual Property Act 2014 is the day after the day on which this Order is made.
