ROAD TRAFFIC

The A3 Trunk Road (Queen Elizabeth Country Park, Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - *18th August 2014*

Coming into force - - *13th September 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A3 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on some of those connecting roads for the purpose of facilitating the holding of a relevant event:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16A(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A3 Trunk Road (Queen Elizabeth Country Park, Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 13th September 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A3 Trunk Road south of Petersfield in the County of Hampshire;

“a slip road” means –

- (i) the road leading from the northbound carriageway of the trunk road at Queen Elizabeth Country Park, or
- (ii) the road leading to the northbound carriageway of the trunk road at Queen Elizabeth Country Park;

“event” means the Butserfest Music Festival; and

“an event period” means a period of 2 days starting at 0001 hours on Saturday 13th September 2014.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during an event period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said event;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

- (d) a vehicle being used for the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency; or
- (e) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
