**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A5 Trunk Road (West of Crick to Weedon Bec,  
Northamptonshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order  
2014**

*Made* - - - - *15th September 2014*

*Coming into force* - - *22nd September 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”) is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, between west of Crick and Weedon Bec in the County of Northamptonshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (West of Crick to Weedon Bec, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 22nd September 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means –

- i. the northbound and the southbound carriageways of the A5 from its roundabout junction with the A428 west of Daventry International Rail Freight Terminal, to the roundabout junction with the A361 at Kilsby; and
- ii. the northbound and the southbound carriageways of the A5 from the roundabout junction with the A361 at Kilsby, to the junction with the A45 at Weedon Bec.

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 29th September 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
