ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5 Trunk Road (Markyate, Hertfordshire) Northbound Lay-by (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - *20th October 2014*
Coming into force - - *27th October 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Hertfordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Markyate, Hertfordshire) Northbound Lay-by (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 27th October 2014.

2. In this Order:

“lay-by” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b); and in this definition “carriageway” means a way constituting or comprised in a trunk road (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“works” means carriageway resurfacing, overlaying of footway, kerb replacement and vegetation clearance in the lay-by;

“the works period” means the period starting at 06:00 on Monday 3rd November 2014 and ending when the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or wait in the lay-by adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the A5 situated 225 metres northwest of the centre line of its junction with London Road, Markyate.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for or in connection with the works, winter maintenance, or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes.
