**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A34 Trunk Road (Peartree Interchange) (Temporary  
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

*Made* - - - - *3rd March 2014*

*Coming into force* - - *22nd March 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A34 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A34 Trunk Road (Peartree Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 22nd March 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A34 Trunk Road near Oxford in the County of Oxfordshire;

“the first length of carriageway” means the southbound carriageway of the trunk road between the slip road leading to the A44 at Peartree Interchange and the slip road leading from the A44 at that Interchange;

“the second length of carriageway” means the northbound carriageway of the trunk road between the slip road leading to the A44 at Peartree Interchange and the slip road leading from the A44 at that Interchange;

“works” mean structural strengthening, resurfacing and all associated work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 9 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 24th March 2014 or on any subsequent weekday until 21st September 2015.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of first and second length of carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;

- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
