**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Duxford
Aerodrome) Regulations 2014**

Made - - - 16th January 2014

Coming into force - - 24th May 2014

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Duxford, Cambridgeshire by reason of the holding of flying displays that are scheduled to take place there on 24th and 25th May, 12th and 13th July and 13th and 14th September 2014.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Duxford Aerodrome) Regulations 2014 and come into force on 24th May 2014.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3(1) all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.

Restricted airspace

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) between—

- (a) 1000 hours and 1700 hours on 24th and 25th May 2014,
- (b) 1200 hours and 1700 hours on 12th and 13th July 2014, and
- (c) 1100 hours and 1700 hours on 13th and 14th September 2014,

no aircraft is to fly below 4,500 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 2.2 nautical miles whose centre is at 520539N 0000753E.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying with the permission of the flying display director at Duxford Aerodrome.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Duxford Aerodrome, Cambridgeshire, during flying displays that are scheduled to be held at the aerodrome on 24th and 25th May, 12th and 13th July and 13th and 14th September 2014.

These events will be open to the general public, and a large number of aircraft will be involved in high-energy manoeuvres during the respective air shows. The Civil Aviation Authority and Department for Transport consider that during the displays, flying should be restricted in the vicinity of Duxford Aerodrome for reasons of public safety.

Full details of the Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
