**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A38 Trunk Road (South Normanton, Derbyshire)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015**

*Made* - - - - 20th February 2015

*Coming into force* - - 27th February 2015

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads, near South Normanton in the County of Derbyshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) , hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (South Normanton, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on Friday 27th February 2015.

2. In this Order:

“M1 Junction 28 Roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A38, B6019 and the slip roads leading to and from the M1;

“the trunk road” means –  
a) the eastbound carriageway of the A38 from the junction with the slip road leading to Birchwood Lane, to the M1 Junction 28 Roundabout;  
b) the westbound carriageway of the A38 from the M1 Junction 28 Roundabout, to the junction with the slip road leading from Bramble Way; and  
c) the M1 Junction 28 Roundabout;

“the slip road” means the slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the A38 from Birchwood Lane;

---

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

---

“the works period”

means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Friday 6th March 2015 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or the slip road.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- c) being used in connection with the said works.
