**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A46 Trunk Road (Warwick, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015**

*Made* - - - - *9th January 2015*

*Coming into force* - - *16th January 2015*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, and one of those connecting roads, at Warwick in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) , hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Warwick, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on Friday 16th January 2015.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the southbound carriageway of the A46 from the junction with the slip road leading to the roundabout junction of the A425/A4177 Birmingham Road, to the junction with the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout at M40 Junction 15;

“the slip road” means the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A46 from the roundabout junction with the A425/A4177 Birmingham Road;

“the works period” means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Saturday 17th January 2015 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
