ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A446 and A452 Trunk Roads (Solihull and Warwickshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015**

Made - - - - 23rd January 2015

Coming into force - - 30th January 2015

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A446 Trunk Road (“the A446”), the A452 Trunk Road (“the A452”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of those trunk roads and on one of those connecting roads, in the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull and the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A446 and A452 Trunk Roads (Solihull and Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on Friday 30th January 2015.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the southbound carriageway of –

- a) the A446 from the junction with the slip road leading to the roundabout junction of the A452, the B4438 Bickenhill Parkway and Solihull Parkway, to the junction with the A452; and
- b) the A452 from the junction with the roundabout described in a) above, to the roundabout junction with the A45 (Stonebridge Island);

“the works period” means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Monday 2nd February 2015 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the southbound carriageway of the A452 at the junction with Packington Lane.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- c) being used in connection with the said works.
