The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Her Majesty The Queen's Birthday Flypast) (Rehearsals) (Revocation) Regulations 2016

Made - - - - *at 12.30 hours on 8th June 2016*

Coming into force - - *with immediate effect*

The Secretary of State previously decided that it was necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of specified parts of Suffolk, Norfolk, Cambridgeshire and Lincolnshire by reason of the holding of rehearsals of a large formation flypast of aircraft, to commemorate Her Majesty The Queen's Birthday, scheduled to take place there.

The Flypast rehearsals having now been cancelled, the Secretary of State no longer considers it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in that area and makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Her Majesty The Queen's Birthday Flypast) (Rehearsals) (Revocation) Regulations 2016 and come into force with immediate effect.

Revocation of Regulations

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Her Majesty The Queen's Birthday Flypast) (Rehearsals) Regulations 2016(b) are revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations revoke the instrument which imposed restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of specified parts of Suffolk, Norfolk, Cambridgeshire and Lincolnshire by reason of the holding of rehearsals of a large formation flypast of aircraft having been cancelled.
