**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Fishburn Air Race)
(Revocation) Regulations 2023**

Made - - - - *21st July 2023*
Coming into force - - *22nd July 2023*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is no longer necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the area specified in regulation 3(1) as the air race in the vicinity of Fishburn Aerodrome has been cancelled.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Fishburn Air Race) (Revocation) Regulations 2023 and they come into force on 22nd July 2023.

Revocation of Regulations

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Fishburn Air Race) Regulations 2023(b) are revoked.
