**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (East of Newhaven)  
(Emergency) Regulations 2024**

*Made* - - - - at 1.24 p.m. on 28th December 2024

*Coming into force* - - at 1.50 p.m. on 28th December 2024

The Secretary of State for a reason affecting the public interest deems it necessary to restrict flying in the area specified in the Schedule by reason of an emergency having arisen in that area.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016(a).

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (East of Newhaven) (Emergency) Regulations 2024 and they come into force at 1.50 p.m. on 28th December 2024.

**Restricted airspace**

2. Beginning at 1.50 p.m. and ending at 5.00 p.m. on 28th December 2024 no aircraft is to fly below 5,000 feet above mean sea level over the area specified in Column 1 of the Schedule, being an area bounded by a circle of the radius specified in Column 2 and centred on the position as specified in Column 3.

3. These Regulations do not apply to any aircraft flying in accordance with directions given by Police Scotland or Edinburgh Airport.
