**AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF
GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE
GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA
CONCERNING THE EXHIBITION OF ARCHAEOLOGICAL
FINDS OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA**

The Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the People's Republic of China;

For the purposes of holding an Exhibition of Archaeological Finds of the People's Republic of China in London;

Have agreed as follows:

ARTICLE I

With a view to developing the good relations and cultural exchanges between the two countries, and following an invitation by the Government of the United Kingdom to the Government of the People's Republic of China, there shall be held at the Royal Academy of Arts in London from the 28th of September 1973 to the 23rd of January 1974 an Exhibition of the Archaeological Finds of the People's Republic of China.

ARTICLE II

The body responsible for the exhibition on the British side is the Chinese Exhibition Council of London. The body responsible for the exhibition on the Chinese side is the Chinese Committee for the Organisation of Exhibitions of Archaeological Finds. The specific arrangements concerning the holding of the exhibition shall be determined between the two bodies mentioned above.

ARTICLE III

Annex A to this Agreement contains a list of the objects to be exhibited; the individual valuation of each exhibit is contained in Annex B to this Agreement. These Annexes shall not be subject to modification except with the consent of the two bodies responsible for the exhibition.

ARTICLE IV

The Government of the United Kingdom shall be responsible for the security of the exhibits listed in Annex A to this Agreement. After the arrival of the exhibits in the United Kingdom, the Government of the United Kingdom shall adopt comprehensive measures to ensure the security of the exhibits and facilitate the smooth handling of the exhibition.

ARTICLE V

The exhibits shall be handed over in Paris by a representative of the Chinese Government to a representative of the Government of the United Kingdom; the procedure for handing over the objects shall be determined between the bodies responsible for the exhibition on the two sides.

ARTICLE VI

In the event that the objects are damaged or lost during shipment from Paris to London, or during the period in which the exhibits are in the United Kingdom, the Government of the United Kingdom shall indemnify the Chinese Government in accordance with the individual valuations of the exhibits set out in Annex B to this Agreement. However, in the event that loss or damage results from acts of force majeure, crash of an aircraft, war or warlike operations or strong earthquakes compensation shall be paid at a rate of 50 per cent of the value listed for the individual items in Annex B to this Agreement.

ARTICLE VII

The Government of the United Kingdom shall co-operate in arranging for the exhibits to be transported from Paris to London. The means of transport shall be decided and paid for by the Chinese Exhibition Council of London.

ARTICLE VIII

Any questions or disputes which may arise in connection with this exhibition shall be settled through consultations between the two Governments.

ARTICLE IX

This Agreement shall enter into force upon signature. It shall remain in force until both sides have fulfilled the obligations arising therefrom.

Done in duplicate at London, this 2nd day of July 1973, in the English and Chinese languages, both texts being equally authoritative.

第 九 条


